CONDITIONS OF ENTRY FOR 2008 EXHIBITION COMPETITION
Final

1. This is a Level 1 Competition.
2. Judging will be conducted in accordance with the current A.F.L.A.C.A. *Competitor & Judging Manual* Issue No. 7, April 2006. Copies of the current manual are available for perusal at the Club Rooms.
3. There is no limit to the number of entries per Member in any section.
4. If, in the opinion of the Competition Committee there are insufficient entries in any section /s to constitute a satisfactory competition, then that or those sections may be combined with a similar section.
5. Faceted stones are to be entered in square boxes suitable for inclusion in display cases.
6. Entry forms can be left in the Entry box at the Club Rooms or posted to the Club to arrive no later than 13 September 2008. (NDLC P0 Box 59 Beecroft 2119).
7. Actual entries, other than Section 0-17, must be received by the Competition Committee no later than 27 September 2008. They will be accepted at the Club Rooms from 12 noon - 4.00 pm on that date or can be handed to the Competition Committee earlier.
8. Entries in Section 0-17 must be delivered to the Hall on Friday 24 October 2008 before 11pm.
9. Individual entries will be available for collection after the Exhibition at 6:00pm on 26 October 2008
10. The Don Hudson Championship Shield will be awarded to the Competitor(s) with the highest aggregate point score of their best entry in any five (5) of the following seven (7) sections: 1A, 1B, 2A, 8A, 18B, 19A, or 25.
11. The Past Presidents Cabochon Trophy will be awarded to the Competitor(s) with the highest aggregate point score of their best entry in any four (4) of the following six (6) sections: 1A, 1BAA, 2A, 3, 4A/B and 13.
12. The Jewellery Trophy will be awarded to the Competitor with the highest aggregate point score of their best entry in any two (2) of the following three (3) sections: 18A-2, 18B or [one of either 19A or 19B].
13. The Alec Campbell Faceting Trophy will be awarded for the highest aggregate point score of the Entrant's best entry in any of the faceting sections – 8A, 9A and 11.
14. The Hugh & less Joyce Carving Trophy will be awarded for the highest individual point score out of either the Open or Novice Carving Sections – O-5A/B or N-5A/B. The entry must have been carved in the preceding two years.
15. The Mathew E. Staley Junior Trophy will be awarded to the Junior Member with the highest aggregate point score of their best entry in any two of the junior sections – 1A, 1A-AA, 1B, 10A, 18B or 18E.
